



Allan Marshall is a spirited world-adventurer and aquatic-animal expert, and The Florida Aquarium's Vice President of Biological Operations. He oversees everything that has to do with the care of our animals. Receiving his BSc in marine biology from the University of Queensland (Brisbane, Australia) in 1988, Allan has worked at eight public aquariums around the world and has extensive experience in aquatic animal care and husbandry, from Cnidarians to marine mammals.

Allan has conducted, supported and managed research, conservation, and educational programs in a variety of disciplines. His specialties include elasmobranchs, aquatic animal transportation, and coral reef husbandry and reproduction. Since 2006 he has been an active member of SECORE (SExual COral REproduction), an international consortium of coral reproduction scientists.

Allan will share his work on Project Piaba, a multi-disciplinary fisheries research project that assists local ornamental fishermen of the Rio Negro in Brazil in collecting, transporting and selling their fishes on the world market. By promoting the sustainable harvest of aquatic resources, Project Piaba will help ensure the survival of both the Amazonian rainforests and its human inhabitants. The Florida Aquarium led an expedition to see this fascinating part of the world and learn about its people. Adult and student participants shared these experiences with school students around the USA via satellite video communications. All took home memories and experiences to last a lifetime.
